

# 2019 IOWA Test

## Test Ordering Instructions

It is that time of year when we all start to wonder how well we have done teaching our kiddos this year! The Iowa test is coming up on May 20-22. If you would like to participate in this testing please order your tests ASAP. It is important that we get the orders in by the beginning of May in order to receive them in time. If the tests are not ordered by May 1st, you may have to pay expedited shipping costs.

In order to purchase your tests follow these steps:

1. Go to <https://www.bjupresshomeschool.com/content/home>
2. Click on the drop down menu "SHOP". Under Other Categories click on Testing & Evaluation.
3. On the right hand side of the screen you will see a menu that says Testing & Evaluation, under this it says shop. Click on the IOWA tests.
4. This year we will be using Form E (copyright 2012). This is important that we all have the same tests, make sure you pick Form E!! Click on Form E.
5. Scroll down and choose the level you want your student(s) to take.
6. Once you click on the appropriate level you will see three options...you must choose the Iowa Assessment (approximately \$25). If you wish to buy the practice test that is up to you (see note below), but the actual assessment is what your student(s) will need in May. Add your appropriate level to your cart and repeat for each child taking the test.
7. When checking out, enter my tester number 78555532 and the date of May 20, 2018. This will allow all tests to be shipped to me and ensure that we have everything we need for each student on testing day!
8. Continue check out and filling in required information.  
Choose FREE shipping (all orders will be held and shipped together).
