# BABIES THROUGH 2nd GRADE

#### **Toddlers**

Supply Fee: \$0

**Description**: Childcare for WALKING children 1-2 years old. Songs, stories and simple games are used to encourage cooperation, sharing and following directions. Activities are chosen to exercise both fine and gross motor skills at a developmentally appropriate level

#### Pre-K3

Teacher: Emily David Supply Fee: \$15

# LANGUAGE COURSES

#### Fun with Spanish

**Teachers**: Valerie Sparks **Grade Level**: 3rd-4th/5th-8th

Supply Fee: \$20

**Description**: This class will focus on fun first. It will incorporate active games to keep the students engaged. Topics to cover will include Greetings, Numbers, and Pronunciation. Games to learn the vowels. Listening, speaking, reading and writing will be the focus. Pencils and notebooks for writing will be included in the supply fee.

The goal for the class will be to come away with a

basic understanding of the Spanish alphabet, Spanish Articles, Gender Rules and Plurals, Key Spanish Verbs, Personal Pronouns and Word Order and Sentence Building.

Basic vocabulary will be covered and the students will have an ability to carry on a simple conversation with ease.

Ultimately, the class will be to demonstrate Spanish is a fun language to learn and speak, so they get a taste for it and want to learn more as they progress in grade levels.

#### Detective Science

more self-aware, and have lots of hands-on fun along the way!

#### Stop Motion Maker

**Teachers**: Jennifer Pourroy **Grade Level**: 3rd-5th/4th-6th

Supply Fee: \$8

**Description**: Stop Motion Maker class is an introduction to stop motion animation on the iPad in an easy going group atmosphere. Students will work in groups of three all semester long, changing teams periodically. We will begin the semester by completing simple activities, while building teamwork skills, and we will progress to longer mini movies with added details like voice over and green screen application. This class will focus on basic stop motion skills through hands on application and guided assignments. Students will use drawings, paper, playdough, lego bricks and other items throughout the semester to complete short animations and mini movies. All equipment and supplies will be provided and students will be working in locked apps offline with their group. While this class is a repeat of last semester (Fall 2023) former students are still welcome. Working on a stop motion film in a group setting is very different than doing one on their own, plus some of the items used or assignments will be switched up this semester. **Please sign up for the appropriate grade level class for your student.** 

#### **Doodle and Draw**

Teachers: Jennifer Pourroy Grade Level: 3rd-6th Supply Fee: \$20

**Description:** Doodle Games & Drawing Tutorials is what this class is all about! This class will doodle around each week playing a fun drawing game followed by a Draw-ivity. We will create Pee-Wee Plants, Optical Illusion Hands and Circle Scenery, plus many other drawings, while following along a simple video tutorial. Each week will flow the same, but a different Doodle Game and Drawivity will happen every class. This is a "for fun" class, while some of our video tutorials may teach simple concepts, the majority will be watch and do style with the goal to just try. This lighthearted class is good for students who sometimes feel artistically challenged, as well as those who like to doodle and draw.

#### Chess Club

**Description**: Open to all levels of chess players, grades 5th and up (high school siblings welcome). The first half of class will focus on discussing game rules and strategies; the latter half will be free play. Chess boards will be provided for in-class use.

# The Human Body

Teachers: Melissa Laster Grade Level: 4th-8th Supply Fee: \$10

**Description:** Let's explore the most amazingly complex creation that God designed, the human body! Using hands-on activities and discussions from a Biblical perspective, we'll learn about a different system each week and how it works to makes our bodies function (skeletal, muscular, dermal, nervous, digestive, respiratory, cardiovascular/circulatory, and senses/reflexes).

Our class will begin with cells and DNA, looking in the book of Genesis to how our Creator made us male and female, but we will not cover anything further in the reproductive system.

#### Will it SLIME?

Teachers: Kayla Schumacher Grade Level: 3rd-4th Supply Fee: \$35

**Description:** We will explore non Newtonian liquids and experiment with polymers. Each week "surprise" ingredients will be presented and the students will vote their predictions whether they will or will not "slime". We will record our hypotheses, discuss our predictions and then proceed with the experiment.

All ingredients will be premeasured and trays/bowls/spoons will be provided to each student as well as containers for travel purposes. After class, the containers will be held in "Slime jail" until the end of coop/PAC day at which time the students will be able to retrieve them before they leave.

# Spies and Detectives: a Hands-on Science Class

Teachers: Nikki Rodriguez Grade Level: 3rd-6th Supply Fee: \$15

**Description:** Have you ever wondered how spies use technology to keep their secrets -- or uncover someone else's? Have you ever wondered how detectives and forensic scientists use the evidence around them to unlock the mysteries at a crime scene? IT'S SCIENCE!!

In this hands-on, experiment-based class, we will look at the science behind spy gadgets and tricks of the trade. We will search for evidence and gather clues. And we will see how science helps spies avoid detection and helps detectives solve real-life crimes.

It's 10 weeks of code-breaking, case-cracking, crime-solving SCIENCE FUN!

#### Life Cycles

Teachers: Brenda Arnaud Grade Level: 3rd-8th Supply Fee: \$40

**Description:** In this class we will be learning the life cycles of Butterflies, Chickens, Frogs and Plants. You'll get your own butterfly to watch from egg to butterfly as well and a grass to watch from seeds to plant. We will be observing and learning all the fun facts

and doing crafts as well!

Zoology

Description: Come learn fun and interesting facts about 10 different animals and we will be doing a craft on each of them.

# HISTORY COURSES ELECTIVES

#### **Beginner Crochet**

Teacher: Michelle Beard Grade Level: 3rd-8th Supply Fee: \$22

**Description:** This class is for students who have never crocheted before. We will be starting with a basic chain stitch and working our way through the five basic stitches of crochet. Each student will receive a set of hooks and notions to keep as well as yarn for their projects.

#### **Crochet Stuffed Animals**

Teacher: Michelle Beard Grade Level: 3rd-8th Supply Fee: \$22

**Description**: In this class we will be learning how to create 3D shapes and make stuffed animals with crochet. Skills covered will include increasing and decreasing, closing a sphere, stuffing, attaching parts and pieces, and changing color. Students should already be able to single crochet a tight fabric with good stitch definition.

## **US Geography**

Teacher: Brenda Arnaud Grade Level: 3rd-8th Supply Fee: \$30

Description: Come learn all about all 50 states! We will be going over fun and important facts as well as doing crafts to help

memorize it all!

#### Introduction to Bushcrafting

Teacher: Dallas Boettcher Grade Level: 4th-8th Supply Fee: \$45

**Description**: We will cover: knots, cordages, shelter materials, tool use/technique, improvised-shelter construction, small-game snares, fire-starting basics, securing gear, core survival principles, resourcefulness, safety, & more.

Parental note: this will be a predominantly outdoor class, even in adverse weather conditions (within the limits of safety protocol). Students will also be handling: \*[fixed-blade knives/hatchets/axes/fire-starting material], rope/cordage, tarps, and other materials. Please be aware of these conditions before signing-up your student.

\*This will all be monitored in one-on-one iterations (students will NOT handle any of the aforementioned tools without direct adult supervision).

\*\*If your student is a 4th grader, please be sure that you feel they will be able to handle the conditions of this class (i.e. weather & tool handling).

#### Easter bonnets and Basic Hatmaking

Teacher: Amber Pohle Grade Level: 3rd-8th Supply Fee: \$15

**Description**: We will learn to construct and decorate fascinators and fabric hats. We will use fabric, buckram, tulle, ribbon, silk flowers, etc. to make hats that we each like. We will make several unique hats each, in our own personal styles, over the course of

the semester.

Description:

The Art Time program develops creative thinking and fosters self-expression through art. Each class starts with a warm-up exercise that targets specific thinking skills and stimulates the creative process. Then, children apply what they've just learned to the art technique presented that day. Students will work with a variety of high-quality materials including pastels, watercolors, foil, poster paint, acrylic paint, clay etc.

Some of the art projects are designed in the styles of the world's famous artists. While learning new art techniques and discovering different styles, it is up to the children to decide exactly how their art will turn out.
